All cut flowers should be home grown, not purchased from florist.

Only the indicated number of stems should be exhibited.

Gladiolus - cut stem in proportion to flower part of stalk.

Exhibitor must furnish proper container. Cut flowers should be shown in bottles, vases or jars.

All entries must be cleaned and groomed for judging.

Exhibitors in patio arrangements, planters and houseplants divisions must maintain their exhibit. Potted plants should be watered the morning of the show and as necessary thoughout the Fair.

The management reserves the right to withhold premiums for ten days after the fair. Any checks not picked up will be mailed.
